This year's catalog id dedicated to the John Dittmar Family.

John Dittmar has been active in the Angora goat business for over 50 years. Joe David's earliest memory of John and Mrs. Dittmar was at a TAGRA show held in Fredricksburg when Tony Hobson of South Africa was in attendance. John had a beautiful C-Type doe that really impressed my Dad and Tony. Since then, John's family has won several championships at the TAGRA and Hill Country Shows/Sales. His goats were known for their density with character but especially those consistent, properly spaced round horns. Nobody has ever produced them better! That is John's trademark.

John has slowed down at the shows but his jovial voice and willingness to show us younger ones what he preferred will always be appreciated. "Be sure to look for kemp on the britch – not just down the back or tail." "We want it fine but still enough volume so that you can feel it between your fingers." "Avoid that dry skin back." In the early 90's when we were working on the American rules for AI and embryos John said "We need some new genetics." That gave us with HLRS some encouragement. In the 80's it was an honor to work and learn on the TAGRA sifting committee with Robert Love and John. They were fair and said what they thought. He was the first one to show me how to keep individual goat records including shearing weights.

John and Mary Louise's three children are still helping with the goats. Connie and Lewis Bratton have their own flocks now and are active with the Mohair Council. Johnny keeps up with the Angoras and meat goats. Dolores and Dr. Castleberry at Castorville still do embryo transfers.

Thanks John and Mary Louise. You have made a difference. Keep telling us what you think.

REFERENCE SIRES

A.B. HOBSON & SONS MARTYRSFORD STUD

- 76 This buck was sired by K131, the twin to the Martyrsford buck that sold for 110,000 Rand, a world record price. He combines the size, muscle, thickness, and correctness of a superior meat goat with a typical soft South African mohair fleece.
- **422 -** This buck was Mike Hobson's selection for the partnership. His sire was an outstanding producer for the Hobsons. Phenotypically this buck is well balanced but not flashy. However, he is a "blue blood" stud, he consistently produces quality kids, both straight South African and "cross".
- 04 In 1994 Mike Hobson, Fred Speck, and Hayden Haby returned to South Africa and selected this buck for the second importation. His conformation is near perfect. His offspring have fine fleeces.
- 80 This buck was also selected by Hobson, Speck, and Haby for the second importation. His sire was a Thorn Park buck purchased at the dispersal sale by A.B. Hobson and Brett Wienand. Haby really likes this big, tall long bodied buck.

JOHN HOBSON THORN PARK ANGORAS

- K590 This buck is still a legend in South Africa. He had great impact on the South African herd and is credited with improving the fineness of their clip. We purchased a number of his offspring at the Thorn park dispersal sale and were successful in landing four daughters, two granddaughters, and one son in Texas.
- 205 Purchased at the Thorn Park Dispersal Sale, this buck was rated highly by John Hobson. He is a big buck with a fine, uniform fleece, showing beautiful style and character. His kids produce heavy, high yielding, fine, uniform fleeces.

HABY-LOCKHART-ROSS-SPECK

HLRS 60- Out of 80 and a "Lockdale" doe imported from South Africa, this buck combines a long stapled fleece with a very correct body conformation. The yearling does on Laura Speck's 1999 Show Circuit were both out of this buck. His two sons at the Sonora Test (JBR) had the longest staple length in 1999.

HLRS 106- Combining a uniform, ringlet fleece with a wide correct body, this buck is also open faced. His sire is 76 and his dam is an imported South African Lockdale doe.

HLRS 110 - Sired by Hobson 76, this 1997 buck with a stylish moderate lock fleece, was kept because of his powerful body structure and level hip - like his sire.

HLRS 215 - This 2nd generation (1998) buck by Hobson 04 was one of our favorites. He was open faced, well structured with a showy fleece. He died this past year. His dam 96-80 was sired by HLRS 12 (uniform with a 0.0 kemp level).

HLRS 300 - Until this year's P.T. he was our highest indexing S.A. buck on the performance test. He carried a fine uniform fleece up front on his neck, as you can see from several bucks in this year's sale. Hobson 422 is the sire. The dam, Hobson 91-081 has been one of the top imported producers.

HLRS 438 - Sired by HLRS 60 (the extra long staple sire) and out of HLRS 98-168 who was sired by HLRS 12. (Thanks Jess for suggesting that several young does be bred to #12). Without a doubt 438 is the finest, most uniform buck that HLRS has raised and he is breeding true, under Fred's evaluations. Notice Lot 32, HLRS 549. Also this years yellow tag #52 at the performance test is a consensus eye catcher with his beautiful style and tremendous body.

ROSS RANCH SIRES

JBR 9759 - Sired by \overline{SA} 422 and out of JBR 9119, a Ross-Kuebel doe (K – 957). She was the finest haired doe on the ranch and produced several keepers. This medium sized buck is thrifty, open faced, has a straight mohair tail, is uniform and he has correct wide legs with a great spring of ribs.

JBR 9946 - This open face buck was in the top 10 indexing bucks at the 2000 performance test. He is sired by FLS 1516 that we purchased in 1998. (A son of FLS 607 who was sired by FLS 404). 9946's dam is JBR 9671 who was sired by HLRS 28. She has raised a kid every year. He a very large, alert buck that remains fine haired.

JBR 9973 - Another 2000 P.T. buck that we bought home to use because of his size and beautiful ringlet style on his neck. He was sired by HLRS 28.

JBR 2025 - Was the 2nd high indexing buck at the 01 performance test. His sire 144 S was purchased for \$2000 from Betty Stewart at the TAGRA sale. The dam was sired by Hobson 76. JBR 2025 is open face, has extra lanolin and above average shearing weight.

163 P.T. - (Performance test). This large open faced buck of Flach – Schmidt (GLS) breeding was purchased in 1990 because of his super body and leg structure.

FLS 2671 - One of FLS 404's last keeper sons. Haby and I liked this buck because of his size, alertness and pedigree including 25% S.A. from Hobson 80 - the large fine haired imported buck.

SPECK RANCH SIRES

H-584 "Superfine" - This legendary Haby stud, along with H-787 "Son of Champ", has provided the foundation of our herd. Both bloodlines have produced champions for Speck Angoras at all major shows in 1990 through 1999.

FLS2-404 - This buck breeds true and has produced super kids. He has excellent conformation with a wide spring of ribs, wide hindquarters, straight back legs, and strong typical horns. he carries a fine, ringlet yearling grade fleece and is uniform from neck to breech. His sire is 4P-210, grand sire is FLS8-43, and great-grand sire is H-787.

FLS1-249 - This is one of the finest fleeced, most uniform bucks we have. His sire is FLS9-68 and his dam, FLS9-76, is a daughter of "Superfine". In 1994 he was the first place Aged Buck at the Kerrville, San Antonio, and Houston Jr. Stock Shows.

FLS4-607 - This son of 404 was Mike Hobson's top choice of our stud prospects in 1995. He has a fine uniform ringlet fleece and breeds true. Several of his doe kids were on our show string. Mike was impressed with his wide body conformation.

FLS4-744 - This buck's sire was a Schmidt buck 3344. His dam was a very fine fleeced daughter of Haby 787. He is an alert, upstanding, uniform fine fleeced buck.

FLS6-1382 - When Hayden Haby & Jesse Lockhart saw this buck as a yearling, they called him the "perfect buck". He has correct horns, thick body, and a fine ringlet long stapled fleece with kid hair. He is a son of 404 and has already produced many excellent kids. He sired the buck kid that Laura Speck won champion buck with at four major shows in 1999.

FLS6-1390 - Out of South African 76, this 1/2 TX buck combines size with a fine dense fleece. His dam, FLS4-646 is a stud doe that won champion doe at major shows as a kid, yearling, and aged doe.

SPECK RANCH SIRES, con't:

FLS7-1593 - Out of HLRS 422, This 1/2 TX buck is long bodied, big, and has a dense rringlet fleece.

FLS8-1810 - A son of 1382, this buck carries a fine ringlet kid fleece and has produced many excellent kids in his first breeding season. His mother is out of 249 and was on the show circuit. she won the Grand Champion Goat of Show in Kerrville in 1997.

FLS9-2062 - Out of Hobson 422, this is an open faced, upstanding alert buck with a fine uniform fleece and excellent conformation. His mother is a fine fleeced doe sired by FLS2-404.

FLS9-2224 - A son of FLS6-1382, this is a show, big, extremely fine-fleeced uniform, ringlet haired buck.

FLS0-2350 - This is a fine-haired, showy buck, 100% Texan, and is a full brother to FLS8-1810.

FLS0-2392 - A son of 1810, this uniform-fleeced buck's dam is out of FLS1-249.

FLS0-2588 - This 100% Texan buck is a grandson of FLS4-607. He is big, long bodied, and showy with a fine fleece.

FLS0-2593 - This 1810 son is 100% Texas bred and has produced excellent kids. He has a super-fine, ringlet fleece.

FLS0-2649- This 75% Texan buck is a grandson of HLRS-422. His sire's bloodline is traced to FLS2-404.

FLS0-2671 - This is a son of 404 with an excellent conformation. He is wide-bodied, level rumped, walks wide, and is showy with a mohair tail. He produces excellent offspring. He is 75% Texan and carries a fine fleece. We credit his body conformation to both his South African grandfather(Hobson-04) and FLS2-404.

LOCKHART SIRES

DL 2219 - Sired by Speck 2043. One of Diana's show bucks. Dam is half South African of #422 stud. Bloodline goes back to our #277 "Bill" stud.

Speck 2407 - A very uniform well covered stud with a beautiful fleece ringlet with nice style and character. One of the many fine haired Speck goats.
