**B**arbara Sanders has not slowed down since she moved from California to Blanket, Texas in 1985. Her great grandparents were pioneers from Spain who had a Spanish land grant in northern California. They loved their horses and land. In 1993 Barbara took some Spanish goats to the Goldthwaite Auction. It was there that she saw her first Angoras and decided to buy four older does and one billy. The Briley and Hipsher families helped her to learn more. The next year she purchased the Hipsher flock and started getting serious. To this day Barbara still works with horses and the Angora goats. As many of us know, the Hipshers, the Durvalls from Coleman and Barbara have really worked together as a team.

"Who is that tall beautiful grey haired lady that is always smiling and helping others?" Barbara is a joy to be around! She supports our industry in many ways – as an officer in TAGRA; has shown her own winners in the show ring; has participated in the performance test, but more importantly as we all have appreciated so much, Barbara works so hard each year to help the youth all around Texas to show and to learn about Angora goats. Jule, Edwin and Delton are quick to point out that Barbara has made the difference in maintaining the Angora influence at the Brown County Livestock Fair. Grandson Cy Tongate has been showing goats for seven years. Both are real proud of each other. We all are proud!

**E**dwin Hipsher and family do not have any Angoras now but have certainly left their footprint, and are still willing to share knowledge. Not only have they shown several champions, but Edwin was president of TAGRA and the American Angora Association in the 1980's. Over the years he has done judging and sifting including the Performance Test. Several of us remember some noteworthy comments Edwin has made. "A goat's body is so important." "None of us have a perfect goat, but I do not want to purchase a billy that has a bad trait that we do not have in our herd." In the 80's he asked the judges to have at least two work sessions to study and update the Texas Angora goat scorecard. "We are seeing too much variation in the placing of the same goats by different judges."

**E**dwin and Jan have lived in Santa Anna now for several years raising cattle. Jan has a specialty photography and gift shop that is located on the main highway close to other stores of local talent. Stop by when in the area!

**D**rs. Lee and Joe Speck have maintained their mixed animal Brown County Animal Clinic for fifty years. Lee and Joe (Fred's cousins) were raised on the ranch in Menard. Central Texas producers have been fortunate to have large animal clinicians all these years who know about sheep and goats.

**D**elton Sweatman is still very much involved with the Brown County Livestock Youth Fair. We still remember how well organized Delton kept the producers 'lots' of mohair at Priour's Ranchman's Wool & Mohair in Brownwood. All of us here today want to express our sympathy to the family of Dale Priour whose funeral was held in Kerrville last week.

**H**erman Moore is still an inspiration to so many of us. He was president of the Mohair Council in the 1980's when the International Council was at its peak. Herman's Stetson hat, pleasant smile and sincerity with Fred Campbell at his side were the face of Texas Mohair around the world. The British Mohair Spinners Award at our performance test and the Hamanaka best bags of Texas Mohair

Competition were established during his leadership. We producers learned a lot and the reputation of USA mohair gained strength. He later served as President of the TSGRA. Give Herman and Fred a call.

A discussion about Brown County, which is still in the drought, would not be complete without thanking Stuart Coleman for his quiet, strong leadership on water and other political issues all across Texas. Republicans and Democrats for years have made trips to Brownwood to seek Stuart's insight. He has served on numerous assignments including the Texas Water Development Board, Region F Water planning and the Pecan Growers Association.

Jule and LaNita Richmond of Blanket continue to be active in our mohair, cattle and farming industries and still take time to be involved in speaking - up for agriculture in Austin and WDC. All three of their grown children are full or part time in ag. LaNita has stepped down from being Executive Director of the Brownwood Chamber, but Jule is on his way to Washington D.C. this weekend to testify on the farm bill. This is his 3rd year to serve as President of the Texas Soil & Water Conservation District Association. Serving as the President of the TSGRA and on the American Sheep Industry Council in 2001, he was instrumental in working with other Texans, western state ASI leaders and Texas Congressman in getting mohair as well as wool to be included in the '01 farm bill again. Jule is quick to point out that Texans working individually and collectively within TSGRA, MCA, ASI, the Farm Bureau, the TX Wildlife Assoc., the Cattle Raisers and the American Goat Federation can indeed make a difference.

We all agree that Brown County continues to be influential for all of agriculture.

## REFERENCE SIRES

### A.B. HOBSON & SONS MARTYSFORD STUD

**76** - This buck was sired by K131, the twin to the Martyrsford buck that sold for 110,000 Rand, a world record price. He combines the size, muscle, thickness, and correctness of a superior meat goat with a typical soft South African mohair fleece.

**422** - This buck was Mike Hobson's selection for the partnership. His sire was an outstanding producer for the Hobsons. Phenotypically this buck is well balanced but not flashy. However, he is a "blue blood" stud, he consistently produces quality kids, both straight South African and "cross".

**04** - In 1994 Mike Hobson, Fred Speck, and Hayden Haby returned to South Africa and selected this buck for the second importation. His conformation is near perfect. His offspring have fine fleeces.

**80** - This buck was also selected by Hobson, Speck, and Haby for the second importation. His sire was a Thorn Park buck purchased at the dispersal sale by A.B. Hobson and Brett Wienand. Haby really likes this big, tall long bodied buck.

### HABY, LOCKHART, ROSS, SPECK

**HLRS 60** - Out of 80 and a "Lockdale" doe imported from South Africa, this buck combines a long stapled fleece with a very correct body conformation. The yearling does on Laura Speck's 1999 Show Circuit were both out of this buck. His two sons at the Sonora Test had the longest staple length in 1999.

**HLRS 606** - This buck has an excellent body conformation with a thick spring of ribs, level rump, and he walks wide. He also carries a uniform, ringlet, yearling fleece. He is out of HLRS 153 (an 04 son) and a Thornpark stud doe #81.

**HLRS-5-734** - A son of HLRS 606, this is a thick bodied fancy buck with a uniform fine fleece. He is one of the best SA bucks we have raised. His mother is out of HLRS 233 (out of HLRS 422 and the stud Lockdale doe, 93-101.)

**HLRS-5-735** - A full brother to HLRS-5-734, he has a very fine kid fleece.

**HLRS-7-821** - This buck is sired by HLRS -3-644 (grandson of HLRS 60). He has excellent body conformation and a uniform fleece.

**HLRS-9-002** - This is an embryo buck from goats we purchased at the Mike Hobson dispersal sale in South Africa. He is a big, robust buck with a soft, uniform fleece. He did well on the show string for Tyler.

**HLRS-9-034**- Another embryo buck with a great body and uniform fleece with a distinct lock style.

**HLRS-9-039**-An embryo buck that is long bodied, has a soft fleece and an open face.

### Ross Ranch Comments

Our kidding starts about the third week of March thru early May. Most of us in the registered goat business make notes about our individual animals. Listed below are some of the codes that we use in our records. For those who want this info, some are reflected on our individual lots in this catalog. We “bag” out all of our does each year (even the commercial ones) since the udder teat structure plays a very important role in % kid crop raised in the pasture. Likewise, we place a strong emphasis on scrotal size, evenness & skin/mohair cover for fertility. Staple length is measured on the side, rump & britch.

### Speck Ranch Sires:

**H-584 “Superfine”** - This legendary Haby stud, along with H-787 “Son of Champ”, has provided the foundation of our herd. Both bloodlines have produced champions for Speck Angoras at all major shows in 1990 through 1999.

**FLS2-404** - This buck bred true and produced super kids. He had excellent conformation with a wide spring of ribs, wide hindquarters, straight back legs, and strong typical horns. He carried a fine, ringlet yearling grade fleece and was uniform from neck to britch. His sire is 4P-210, grand sire is FLS8-43, and great-grand sire is H-787.

**FLS1-249** - This was one of the finest fleeced, most uniform bucks we had. His sire is FLS9-68 and his dam, FLS9-76, is a daughter of “Superfine”. In 1994 he was the first place Aged Buck at the Kerrville, San Antonio, and Houston Jr. Stock Shows.

**FLS6-1382** - When Hayden Haby & Jesse Lockhart saw this buck as a yearling, they called him the “perfect buck”. He has correct horns, thick body, and a fine ringlet long stapled fleece with kid hair. He is a son of 404 and has produced many excellent kids.

**FLS8-1810** - A son of 1382, this buck always carried a fine ringlet kid fleece and produced many excellent kids. He was one of our top producers. His mother was out of 249 and was on the show circuit. She won the Grand Champion Goat of Show in Kerrville in 1997.

**FLS9-2224** - A son of FLS6-1382, this is a showy, big, extremely fine fleeced uniform ringlet haired buck.

**FLS0-2350** - This is a fine-haired, showy buck, 100% Texan, and is a full brother to FLS8-1810. He produces good kids.

**FLS0-2407** - Hayden Haby, Jesse Lockhart, and Joe David Ross purchased this buck at the 2001 HLRS sale. Hayden loaned him to me for two breeding seasons. His offspring have very fine uniform fleeces and an open face. He is a son of FLS 1337 (out of 607...404). The buck has maintained a ringlet, superkid fleece.

**FLS2-3136** - This showy buck combines a beautiful fleece with an excellent body conformation. He is a son of FLS0-2593 (son of 1810). He is 100% Texan.

**FLS2-3206** - This son of FLS8-1810 is 100% Texan and has a very fine fleece.

**FLS2-3214** - This showy buck has a wide spring of rib and a beautiful ringlet fleece. He is 75% Texan out of FLS0-2593.

**FLS3-3407** - This 100% Texas bred buck is out of FLS1-2763 (1810 son). He is a large buck with an open face and a fine fleece.

**FLS3 3505** - This son of FLS1-2898 (out of 2224) has produced great kids. He is big, robust, open faced, and has a ringlet kid fleece. We kept several bucks he sired over the past four years.

**FLS4-3724** - A son of FLS2-3214, this is a fancy, fine fleeced buck. He is 87.5% Texan.

**FLS4-3866** - This son of FLS0-2350 has a dense, very long stapled, uniform kid fleece.

**FLS5-4327** - I loved the fine, ringlet, dense fleece on this showy buck. He is out of FLS9-2224.

**FLS6-4503** - This was one of our favorite bucks. He is out of FLS3-3505. He is open faced, large, thick and has a fine, uniform, ringlet fleece.

**FLS6-4552** - This is a big, robust, fine fleeced buck. He is 100% Texan. His sire is 3136 and dam is out of 2224.

**FLS6-4562** - This 50% Texas buck is out of HLRS-2-606. He is long bodied, thick, large, upstanding and has a ringlet fine fleece.

**FLS7-4846** - This 100% Texan buck has a gorgeous ringlet long staple fleece with 1+ grease. His sire is 2407 and his mother is stud doe 668 (1810, 2350, 2844). He has done well on Tyler's show string.

**FLS8-5139** - This fancy buck is in the photo on our sale catalog. In 2012 he won Champion Buck as an aged buck at the Kerrville District Show (largest Angora goat show in U.S.). He still carries a ringlet, uniform superkid fleece. He is out of FLS4-3866 and has a thick structurally correct body. He is 81% Texan.

**FLS8-5225** - An upstanding, showy buck with a superkid, ringlet fleece. His sire is FLS2-3206. He is 75% Texan.

**FLS9-5374** - This fancy buck is out of FLS4-3866. He is 84% Texan and has a ringlet superkid fleece.

**FLS9-5395** - This buck is out of FLS3-3505. He is 81% Texan, has a ringlet fleece and thick body.

**FLS9-5406** - This son of FLS3-3505 has an excellent body conformation and a fine ringlet, kid fleece. He is 75% Texan

**FLS9-5419** - His sire is FLS4-3724. He also has a ringlet kid fleece and correct body. He is 81% Texan.

**FLS9-5456** - Another son of FLS3-3505 with a wide body and fine, ringlet fleece. 87.5% Texan. He produces great kids.

**FLS9-5613** - Another great bodied, fine fleeced buck out of FLS3-3505.

**FLS9-5632** - This 100% Texan buck is out of FLS2-3136. He carries a ringlet fleece with extra staple length and 1+ grease.

**FLS9-5678** - This 87.5% Texan buck is an 1810 great grandson. Haby really liked this buck's father, a robust, wild-eyed, crazy, fence jumping buck.

**VACCINATIONS** - All Speck goats were vaccinated at 6 months of age for CL and given a booster this spring. As with any vaccine, this will not totally eliminate the disease but will significantly reduce the incidence. At four months of age they were vaccinated with Sore mouth and CDT.

**Even though** we breeders have similar standards and breeding programs, the animals have been raised in different environments, management and kidding dates. Please make notes of these differences and make visual comparisons of individual animals from within that specific herd.
